
Roy Wood Jr. is a comedian, an Emmy-nominated documentary producer for the PBS documentary *The Neutral Ground*, and for 8 years served as a correspondent on Comedy Central's Emmy-winning *The Daily Show* (2015–23). Spring of 2023, Wood Jr. guest hosted *The Daily Show* and headlined the *White House Correspondents' Dinner* to its highest ratings since 2017.

Wood Jr. co-starred alongside Jon Hamm in Paramount Pictures' long-awaited Fletch remake, *Confess, Fletch* (2022), and has guest appearances in 'Only Murders in the Building', 'Better Call Saul', 'The Last O.G.' & 'Space Force.'




Born Orville Richard Burrell and raised in Kingston, Jamaica, Shaggy got his start as an MC in New York City's burgeoning dancehall scene soon after moving to Brooklyn in his teens. Not long after serving four years in the U.S. Marines he inked his first record deal and quickly scored a global crossover smash with "Oh Carolina." As the only diamond-selling dancehall artist in music history, Shaggy has sold more than 40 million album units to date, landed eight singles on the Billboard Hot 100 and seven albums on the Billboard 200 with four on the Top 40. He has received 2 Grammy Awards and is among the top 3 streamed reggae artists of all time on Spotify.

Not only a pioneering reggae/dancehall icon, multi-award-winning songwriter and hitmaker, Shaggy has long used his platform to strengthen his community and homeland. In 2009, he established the Shaggy Make a Difference Foundation and organized the first of many, Shaggy & Friends benefit concerts, which to date have raised millions for the Bustamante Children's Hospital located in Kingston. "I always try to bring the fun when I'm performing, and keep everything very lighthearted and joyous," says Shaggy. "I think my purpose and my job is to bring joy to as many people as I can, and I want that to resonate within all of the music that I create." Family, welcome "Mr. Boombastic" himself, Shaggy!

Born Joseph Saddler on January 1, 1957 in the South Bronx, Grandmaster Flash is inarguably one of the original innovators of Hip Hop. He is recognized as one of the architects of Hip Hop and a builder of the culture, the first DJ to make the turntable a musical instrument by the way of his Quik Mix Theory formula and homed devices. His technical innovations and artistic contributions have earned him numerous accolades. His impact on the music industry extends beyond his own successful career, as his innovative formula and sounds were translated to production technologies and have inspired generations of DJs, producers and artists to push the boundaries of creativity.

In the earliest days of the genre, he manipulated music by placing his fingers on the vinyl, perfected beat looping, and discovered many of the most iconic beats still commonly sampled today. The New York Times calls him the first virtuoso of Hip Hop. Today, he is the voice of an entire generation of 1970s Hip Hop pioneers. From his electric live shows to his production role on Netflix's "The Get Down", Grandmaster Flash is a historian, storyteller and a cultural force. The music of the 1970s fueled the rise of Hip Hop, but much of the influence from that decade has been lost to time. With access to archival master recordings, images, and videos from the vaults, the Grandmaster Flash live show is a celebration of the most formative decade in Hip Hop history.
